LEGO® Design Honor: Set Recommendations

For anyone that does not own a LEGO® set, this honor can be completed with 1 of the larger Classic or Creator sets usually. It is not ideal since these sets typically do not contain a minifigure. It is of course easier to build some scenes using the minifigure people, but you can build simple representations of people with bricks as well.

Currently available sets that I recommend are the following: set numbers 10698 (790 pieces) & 10717 (1500 pieces) are shown below and are available at some Walmart locations for \$35. Note on average a set will cost about \$0.10 per piece. Sets with more specialized pieces or trademark licenses, like Star Wars® will cost more. And sets with less unique pieces, like #10717 will be the most cost effective. This is important to consider as LEGO® can be very expensive.

There are other building block brands that you can use for this honor. However, the LEGO® brand was selected to be primary product for this honor due to its long product history, quality of product, and availability of product worldwide. Other brands tend to use lower quality of plastics and lower specifications for consistency of measurements. This means, over time, the other brands wear out faster or may even not hold together during the building process.
